1. Does your church/organization have a written fire/earthquake plan?
2. Does your church/organization have a trained security team?
3. What does your church/organization do in case of a disruptive/dangerous person during services?
4. How would you handle someone under the influence of drugs/alcohol or mental disorder?
5. Do you monitor your parking lot areas during church/organization hours?
6. Have you had vandalism problems in the past 6 months?
7. Do you have trained security personnel for any non-church gatherings at your site?
8. Do you have First Aid/disaster kits placed at appropriate locations and have them checked regularly?
9. Do you have trained personnel and plans for handling and transport of monies?
10. Do you have a true "secure" area for storage of monies?
11. Do you have trained emergency medical responders with plans and the necessary equipment readily accessible at all church functions?
12. Do you have updated evacuation/emergency plans for all occupied buildings?
13. Do you identify (by designated personnel) any medical personnel in the audience during your services?
14. Do you have an emergency electronic response system for your children's area?
15. Do you have a wrench attached to your main gas shut off valve?
